Advanced Service: NHS Flu Vaccination Service 2019/20	Service Income	Service provision starts from 1 st September 2019	<p>Please read:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> service specification and the Patient Group Direction for the NHS Flu Vaccination Service 2019/20. <p>The changes to the NHS Flu Vaccination Service 2019/20 are below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The fee for the service will increase to £8.08 per administered dose plus an additional fee of £1.50 per vaccination, making the total payment £9.58; Due to the proven success of the service, community pharmacy contractors are no longer required to ask patients to complete a patient questionnaire after they have received a flu vaccination; Notification of the patient having received a vaccination can no longer be sent to the patient's GP practice by fax. Claims for payments must now be made using the NHSBSA Manage Your Service (MYS) platform. <p>Training and Declaration of Competence: The learning and assessment have also been reviewed and the CPPE Immunisation programme has been withdrawn.
