CPCS IT deadline approaching: Have you confirmed your choice of system?

The national procurement of IT support for the CPCS is due to finish at the end of March 2022. Contractors that want to continue providing the service must, therefore, confirm their choice of CPCS IT system by no later than **February 2022**. Those contractors who choose to stay with their current IT provider still need to confirm this. Learn more about the CPCS provider pays model here.

Note GP CPCS referrals via EMIS Patient Access or PharmRefer which is in place across Surrey and Sussex will continue to be sent via PharmOutcomes at no cost. An IT provider needs to be agreed and in place for any GP CPCS referrals via NHS mail or NHS 111 referrals.

Complete PSNC's Pharmacy Pressures Survey

PSNC is increasingly hearing from pharmacy teams who are struggling to cope with ongoing financial and operational pressures, and who are concerned about the impact that the strain on the sector will ultimately have on patients.

PSNC are continuing to raise this with policy-makers, making clear the consequences that their decisions are having. To further support those discussions, they have today launched two surveys to gather more data on the pressures that everyone working in community pharmacy is under and the impact that this is having.

These surveys will give PSNC a snapshot of the scale of the problems and the survey results will be used in their ongoing discussions with NHS England & NHS Improvement (NHSE&I) and the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC). They will also help them to continue to make pharmacy's case in our conversations with MPs, Ministers and through the national media.

There are two separate surveys, one for <u>Pharmacy business owners/head office</u> <u>representatives</u>, and the other for <u>Pharmacy teams</u>. <u>Find out more about PSNC's</u> <u>Pharmacy Pressures Survey</u>.
