Pharmacy Advice Audit 2022 extended

Bank Holiday opening hours declaration

NHS England would like to remind pharmacies who are yet to submit their Bank Holiday Declaration that the original deadline has passed. The opening hours declarations are vitally important for NHS England to ensure adequate pharmaceutical coverage across the South East region during the Bank Holiday periods. Please note if you intend to be closed, you are still required to provide a declaration. Please could you submit your opening hours declaration no later than 28th February 2022. Please remember to check PharmOutcomes and clear through any outstanding referrals. It is vital that claims are submitted on MYS each month to ensure you get paid for the service, a report can be generated in PharmOutcomes to support you to upload the information on MYS. To download the details on how to generate the report click here.

Pharmacy Quality Scheme

Contractors must make their declaration between 3pm on Thursday 3rd February 2022 and 11.59pm on Wednesday 2nd March 2022).

Contractors now have from 1st April 2021 **until 5th April 2022** to claim payments for the completion of a minimum of 20 completed New Medicine Service (NMS) provisions; this is a Gateway criterion.

For the other scheme requirements, contractors have until 31st March 2022 to complete the domains and until 30th June 2022 to gather the evidence to demonstrate compliance, except for the following:

- **PCN Domain** this requires collaborative work on flu vaccination uptake which had to be completed by 31st December 2021.
- Advice on return of unwanted and used inhalers (Respiratory Domain) the
 end of the period during which pharmacy teams should have had conversations
 with patients dispensed an inhaler was the 31st January 2022.
