Regarding your stock, the local authority will be unable to take this back as the Targeted Community Testing programme will cease. If you can distribute to a care home/hospital in your area after the 31st March, who can make use of these tests please do so. As you are aware the stock cannot be given to the general public as they need to be administered by a professionally trained assistant. If you need to dispose of the stock, this can be placed in the **general rubbish** and not your clinical

waste.

Urgent recall

You should have received a communication from Abbott regarding a Product Recall for Elecare Similac and Alimentum Similac infant formula powders, because they might contain Salmonella and Cronobacter sakazakii.

Abbott's advice to consumers is -

If you have purchased or been prescribed any of the above product batches, do not feed it to your baby and return to the place of purchase. If you have additional questions, please contact Abbott on 01795 580303

The MHRA urges healthcare professionals to contact all patients who have been dispensed the impacted* batches immediately.

*All batches of Elecare Similac and Alimentum Similac infant formula powders are being recalled, therefore patients will need to be changed to an alternative product.
