Delivery of quit smoking campaign materials

The Better Health quit smoking campaign is the last mandated campaign agreed for 2021/2022 by NHS England and NHS Improvement (NHSE&I) and PSNC.

Resources for the campaign will be delivered to community pharmacies via Yodel between 24th February and 28th February 2022. Contractors must participate in the campaign from 28th February until 31st March 2022. Find out more about this health campaign.

Pharmacy advice audit extended

Community pharmacy contractors and their teams are being asked to take part in PSNC's latest Pharmacy Advice Audit. The audit has been extended but results must be submitted by **23.59 on Friday 11th March 2022**. We are very grateful to anyone able to take part in this audit.

FP34C paper submissions to cease

The last paper FP34C submission document will be posted out to contractors in February 2022. After this month, contractors will no longer receive paper FP34C submission documents in the post. From April 2022 (for prescriptions dispensed from March 2022), the Manage Your Service (MYS) portal will be the ONLY route available to contractors for all monthly FP34C submissions. Pharmacy contractors who have not already registered for MYS can download and complete the form on the MHSBSA's website and send it to nhsbsa.mys@nhs.net.
