PQS Aspiration Payment	Pharmacy Income	Complete by 11.59pm on 4 th November 2022	Community pharmacy contractors have just over a week left to claim an Aspiration payment for the Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) 2022/23. The deadline for claiming this payment is 11.59pm on the 4th of November 2022. Contractors wishing to claim for an Aspiration payment should review the requirements of the PQS 2022/23, decide which domains they want to work towards meeting by the end of 31st March 2023, and declare this on the NHS Business Services Authority (NHSBSA) Manage Your Service (MYS) portal. The maximum number of points for which a contractor can be paid an Aspiration payment is 70% of the number of points within the band in which they are placed. The value of each point for the aspiration payment is set at £67.50 (i.e. the minimum value of a point for PQS 2022/23). Please note, the Aspiration payment is optional; if contractors do not want to claim it, it will not impact on the contractor's ability to claim a PQS payment during the declaration period. There is also no requirement to have claimed for a previous PQS to claim an Aspiration payment for PQS 2022/23. Find out more.	
Christmas and New Year opening	Contractual Requirement	Complete by 19 th November 2022	Please note that New Year's Day (Sunday 1st January 2023) is a normal working day for community pharmacy opening hours. If the hours that the pharmacy wishes to close early are supplementary hours, then notice of that intention should be given at least 5 weeks in advance. If they are core hours, then an application is needed, and the contractor would have to satisfy NHS England that there have been changes to the needs of people in the area, otherwise the application is likely to be refused. If contractors want to reduce their hours, for example, to close early on Christmas Eve, they must give notice to NHS England at least 5 weeks in advance, unless NHS England agrees otherwise. Therefore, the last day to give notice for 24th December, for any guaranteed reduction in supplementary hours, is on 19th November and NHS England must receive the notification, for example, by email, on or before that date. Unless you have notified NHS England of changes to your supplementary hours at least 5 weeks before the date, or applied successfully for amendment of core hours, you are unlikely to be able to close early.	

Community Workforce Survey	Contractual Requirement	Complete by 30th November 2022	Note the NHS regulation for changing supplementary hours changed on the 1st of October 2022. From 3 months to 5 weeks for reducing supplementary hours and no notice is required for an increase in supplementary hours. There is now a mandatory requirement to complete the 2022 Community Pharmacy Workforce Survey, managed by Health Education England (HEE), by 30th November 2022. The NHS Business Services Authority sent an email to pharmacy contractors on 6th October 2022 containing a link to the survey. In some cases, e.g. Company Chemists' Association member companies and other larger multiple pharmacy groups, head offices will complete the survey centrally. If you are not sure whether the survey will be completed centrally, please ask your head office for guidance. Find out more about the survey	
NHS Profile Manager	Contractual Requirement	Complete by 31 st December 2022	Ensure the DoS and NHS.uk website pharmacy profile is comprehensive and accurate by updating via the NHS Profile Manager. Verify and where necessary, update the information contained in the profile at least once each quarter. The financial quarters are: • 1st April to 30th June • 1st July to 30th September • 1st October to 31st December • 1st January to 31st March Reminder of the new NHS Profile Manager tool for updating DoS & NHS website
