Reminder - Pharmaceutical Waste Collection

Anenta Ltd manage the pharmaceutical waste services contract for NHS England excluding sharps (**please see sharps**). Note NHSE South East confirmed that used or unused adrenaline auto-injectors e.g. EpiPens, Jext are excluded from the usual sharps requirements and can be taken back by the pharmacy and put into the pharmaceutical waste bin.

Anenta are your first point of contact for ALL pharmaceutical waste matters. **Anenta is a waste managing agent**, not a waste collector and will help you if you have concerns or complaints about **missed collections** or **require additional** **collections**. Tell Anenta your concerns about your waste collections and they will contact your waste collector – *Stericycle* or *Cannon Hygiene* on your behalf. The pharmacy can do this by logging into the pharmacy account and completing a ticket on the Anenta website.

If the pharmacy is not registered you can do this **using this short form** (you will receive an immediate email confirmation to the address you registered with, then a subsequent email telling you how to use the service).
