You are invited to attend the Community Pharmacy and University Hospitals Sussex (UHSX) launch of the advanced SCS service on Tuesday 13th February 7pm-8:30pm. Hosted by Community Pharmacy Surrey and Sussex with Guest speaker's Steve King NHS England SCS Implementation Team MLCSU, NHSE, EMIS and Hospital colleagues.

This service has been designed to enable NHS trusts to undertake a transfer of care on patient discharge, referring patients (where they consent) to a community pharmacy of their choice to continue their smoking cessation treatment, including providing medication and support as required.
