### Services across Surrey & Sussex

[Essential services](#) – these are provided by all pharmacy contractors as part of the NHS Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF), also known as the ‘pharmacy contract’.

[Advanced services](#) – there are currently nine Advanced Services within the NHS Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF). Community pharmacies can choose to provide any of these services as long as they meet the requirements set out in the Secretary of State Directions.

[Locally commissioned services](#) – these are local services mainly commissioned by Public Health within the Local Authorities across Surrey and Sussex. Integrated Care Systems and others can also commission local services from community pharmacy to meet the needs of their patients.
