Community Pharmacy Surrey & Sussex is a mechanism to allow more effective collaboration between LPCs, pool resources and share costs as well as implementing initiatives of shared interest in common areas. It is governed by the CPSS Executive Committee.

Surrey Local Pharmaceutical Committee and Sussex Local Pharmaceutical Committee are recognised by the NHS as the statutory organisations representing community pharmacies.
